Celiac disease is an autoimmune disorder where the ingestion of gluten triggers an immune response that attacks the small intestine. When the intestine is damaged, nutrients cannot be absorbed properly into the body. This disease affects about 1% of the population, but over 2.5 million Americans are undiagnosed. Left untreated, celiac disease can lead to other serious health problems including development of other autoimmune diseases like Type I diabetes and multiple sclerosis (MS), dermatitis, herpetiformis (an itchy skin rash), anemia, osteoporosis, infertility and miscarriage, neurological conditions like epilepsy and migraines, short stature and intestinal cancers. Currently, there is no medication or cure for celiac disease, and the only treatment is a lifelong adherence to a strict gluten-free diet.
